

## **Malala Reflection Essay Test Grade**

5 Paragraphs: 20 points each

For paragraphs 2 and 3, put the page numbers at the end of the paragraph. Example (pp. 22, 23, 145-148)

**Paragraph 1:** Summary of the story. (Think about back covers of books. They aim to attract the potential reader by describing where the story takes place, some of the main characters, and the major conflict or struggle the main character has to face or overcome.) 4-6 sentences.

**Paragraph 2:** Describe TWO moments that moved or inspired you and why. (page numbers) 4-6 sentences.

**Paragraph 3:** Describe the moment that shocked you the most and why. (page numbers) 2-4 sentences.

**Paragraph 4:** If you could meet her in person, what words would you have for Malala? Write 3-5 sentences.

**Paragraph 5:** Take aways: What did you gain from reading this book? 3-5 sentences.
